### Planting Information

Prefers well-drained, fertile soil high in organic matter, pH 6.0 to 7.5. This heavy feeder needs a lot of consistent moisture. Sow 1/4 inch deep and 1/2 inch apart in sterile seedling mix. Transplant outside when there are 6 to 8 leaves.

As soon as the ground can be worked in the spring, you can direct sow outdoors about 1/4 inch deep and 1 inch apart in rows 15 to 20 inches apart. Wait until early fall to plant a second crop, after the hottest afternoon temperatures have passed.

### Growing Information

Mulch around plants can help maintain moisture and reduce weeds.

### Harvesting and Storing Information

For tender, sweet kohlrabi, harvest them when they are less than 2 inches in diameter. Larger plants become woody and bitter. You can store at 34 degree F and high humidity.

### Insect and Disease Information

Cabbage worms are small green larva of the cabbage white butterfly. You can use row covers to keep them from eating small plants; hand pick and destroy on older plants. Aphids can be periodically sprayed off with a stream of water. Keeping the soil pH at or above 7.2 will help suppress club-rot; if needed, adding lime will raise your soil pH.
